MISSION: Macris School is a Catholic, bilingual institution that seeks to develop students of integrity who are prepared both academically and spiritually to excel in higher education and to be lifelong learners and leaders of positive change.

ABOUT MACRIS

Macris is a Pre-K-12 institution that enrolls approximately 1,200 students annually, comprising three distinct areas: preschool (ages 2-5), elementary school (grades 1-6), and high school (grades 7-12). The school follows a dual academic program, blending American and Honduran educational standards. Students are divided into three sections by grade of approximately 23 students in which they take classes together as a group. In high school, class sections are rearranged within grade levels each year according to academic performance and behavioral needs.

Macris High School offers a college preparatory curriculum that equips students to graduate with both a Honduran diploma (Bachillerato internacional en ciencias y humanidades) and a U.S. High School diploma. The instructional language for approximately 80% of the classes is English, aligning with international educational standards, while subjects pertinent to Honduran culture, such as Civics, Spanish, and Honduran History, are taught in Spanish, in compliance with the requirements set forth by the Honduran Secretary of Education.

Seniors are also mandated to contribute 144 hours of community service as part of a government program. This service typically involves activities such as promoting literacy skills in local underprivileged communities or participating in reforestation efforts. This commitment to community service plays a pivotal role in shaping a comprehensive education while instilling the values of civic responsibility in our students.

CLASS SCHEDULE

A regular class day consists of five one-hour synchronous class periods. This structured schedule ensures comprehensive coverage of all subjects and is facilitated through a well-organized five-day rotating system, following a block schedule.

AP COURSES

Macris School currently offers the following AP Courses: **AP Calculus AB, AP Spanish Language and Culture, AP English Literature and Composition, AP Statistics, AP Human Geography.**

Although we offer five AP courses, our students often take the initiative to independently prepare for additional AP subjects not available in our curriculum, demonstrating their commitment to academic excellence and taking on a rigorous course load.

SCHOOL HOUSES

GPA CALCULATION

GPA calculation is based on the academic model suggested by College Board. Students usually take 40 credits per school year except students who take AP courses or those who only complete the U.S. diploma and not the Honduran one. Our students are ranked by their weighted cumulative average from 9th-12th grade.

HONOR ROLL

Our Honor Roll recognizes achievement at three levels: High Honor Roll (95%-100%), Honor Roll (90%-94%) and Honorable Mention (85%-89%). In addition to achieving the specified averages, students must demonstrate excellent citizenship during each specific quarter. Students are ranked using the final average of their annual grades.
